NOTICE OF CASUAL VACANCY

Notice is hereby given that by reason of the resignation of Councillor Les Maguire and the disqualification of Councillor Robert Milton two vacancies have occurred for the **Morda with Sweeney Ward** of Oswestry Rural parish.

The Parish Council must now fill these vacancies by co-option with persons eligible for Council membership. Anyone interested must be qualified by virtue of being a British or Commonwealth Citizen, citizen of the Republic of Ireland or European Union citizen, who has attained the age of 18 years and is:

- a) registered as a local government elector for the parish of Oswestry Rural; and/or who has
- b) during the whole of the twelve months preceding the appointment occupied as owner or tenant land or other premises in the parish; and/or their
- c) principal or only place of work during those twelve months has been in the parish; and/or has
- d) during those twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 kilometres of it;

and is not disqualified from holding office by reason of any disqualification set out in Section 80 of the Local Government Act 1972.

Any person interested in filling this vacancy should apply to the Clerk in writing.

A person is not eligible to stand for election/co-option for any of the following reasons:

- 1. If they hold a paid office with the Council.
- 2. If they receive any profit or gift from the Council.
- 3. If they are a member of any committee or sub-committee of the Council.
- 4. If they are a paid officer of any committee or sub-committee of the Council.
- 5. If they are subject to a bankruptcy restrictions order.
- 6. If they have been convicted of any offence within the last five years or taken part in any illegal practices.
